Beginner Level (5:00 - 5:55 pm): This chess class is for 1-5th students who want to learn basic knowledge of chess: the moves of the pieces, relative values of chess pieces, opening principles, basic checkmates, and tactics like forks, pins, doubled attacks, and discovered checks.
