Aspiring performers will enroll in a 10 week
drama program that will help to develop self-
confidence and improve communication skills.

Students will be both challenged and
encouraged to explore their creative potential in
a non-competitive environment.

Each week, students will engage in acting
exercises, theater games, ensemble singing,
and movement. This session is for beginners
and will focus on the process of theatre. It is
designed to prepare them for **Mini K.I.D.S.** (1st
and 2nd graders) where they will have the
opportunity to actually stage a mini-musical.

The 10 week program will culminate with
parents and guardians invited to the final class
for a **Kinder K.I.D.S. Showcase.**
